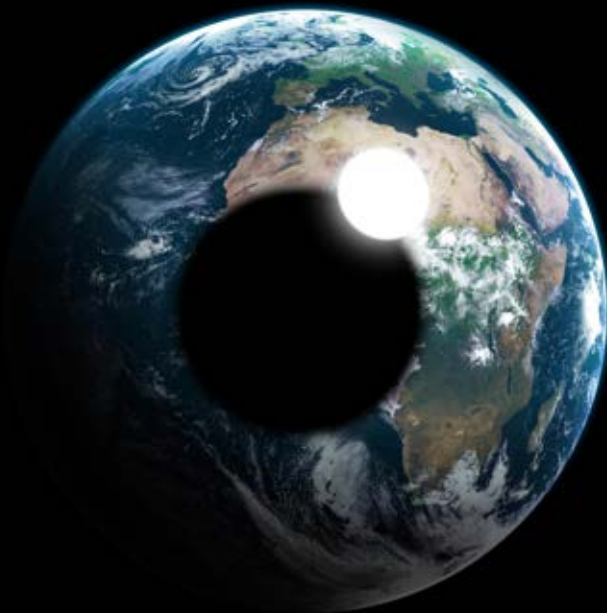

MSc in Primary Care Ophthalmology:

High quality education and training for the next generation of optometrists, ophthalmic nurses, orthoptists and other ophthalmic Allied Health Professionals, medical and surgical trainees and GPs with a Special Interest in Ophthalmology.

Three year, part-time, interprofessional programme, taught entirely online, is offered by the University of Edinburgh in partnership with the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh, leading to degree of Master of Science (MSc), with exit points at PG Diploma (after two years of study) and PG Certificate levels (after one year of study). Designed to be completed alongside an ophthalmic clinical post.

Supports the acquisition of applied knowledge in the ophthalmic sciences, examination and investigation, referral, treatment and management of the ophthalmic patient, equipping ophthalmic health professionals with the key academic and clinical tools to support their lifelong learning throughout their training and ophthalmic career. COVID-19-related ophthalmic modules focus on recovery strategies in ophthalmic service delivery.
